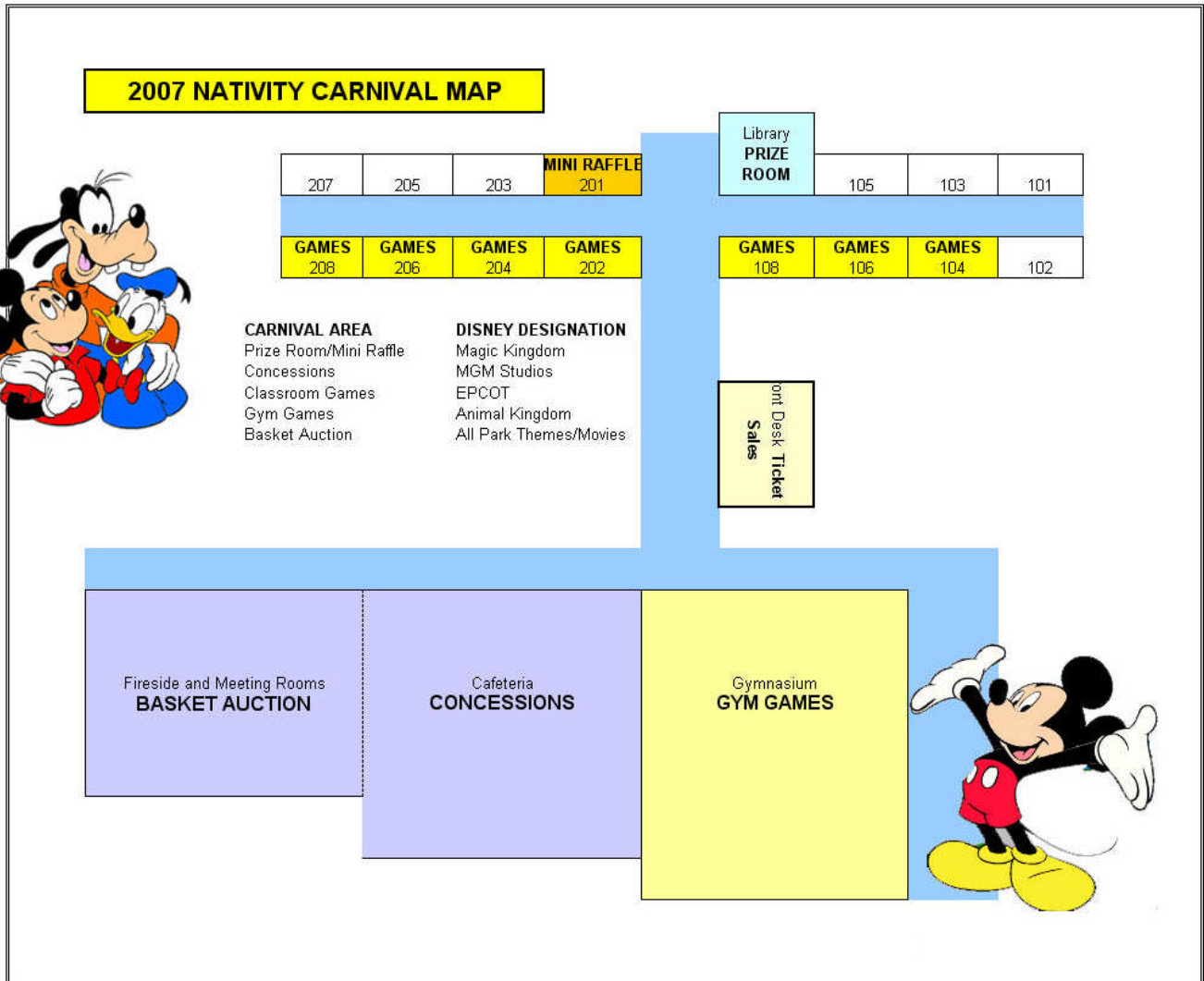

But there's still help that is needed. How can you help? Please consider helping with the following Carnival needs:

- **Individual Candies** - Bagged candy that can be divided into separately wrapped candies for prizes in the game rooms. These are presently being collected and can be left at the Front Desk anytime between now and the Carnival.
- **Small Prizes** - Small toy and prize items that range in price from \$1.00 - \$5.00 for the Prize Redemption Room (including any toys that are obtained from such establishments such as Burger King, McDonald's, etc. *Please do not donate used toys and items, as items need to be in their original state.*
- **Mini-Raffle Prizes** - Small toy and prize items that range in price from \$5.00 - \$25.00 for the Mini-Raffle and Jackpot Drawings during the Carnival evening. *Please do not donate used toys and items, as items need to be in their original state.*
- **Cakes/Bars and Soda/Sports Drink** - These cakes/bars can be any size and will be used for the Cake Walk game throughout the evening of the carnival. If you are able to contribute these items, please leave them on the tables next to the Front Desk no earlier than Wednesday, January 31. As well, one of the Carnival games is in need of soda and sports drinks. If you are able to contribute to this cause, please bring any sports drinks and/or soda to the tables next to the Front Desk of the Nativity School. Bottles should be approximately 20 ounces and can be brought in any time between now and the Carnival, on Feb. 2.

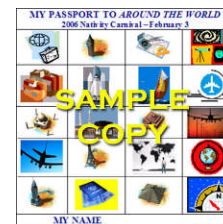
**COME EARLY, STAY LATE!**
